SHOW RULES

- 1. All members of the public are invited to submit exhibits at Culmore Annual Show.
- 2. Entry fee 50p per exhibit in all adult classes. 25p per exhibit in children's classes. Entry fee must accompany entry form.
- 3. Points will be awarded as follows:- 4 points for 1st prize/3 points for 2nd prize/2 points for 3rd prize/1 point for highly commended.
- 4. Prizes:-1st prize £1.50/ 2nd prize £1.00/ 3rd prize £0.50.
- 5. No prize will be awarded if, in the opinion of the judges, an exhibit fails to reach a certain standard of excellence expected.
- 6. An exhibitor who wins more than one prize in any class will only be awarded the points towards a trophy for the highest prize.
- 7. In the Flower, Fruit and Vegetable Sections ALL exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor.
- 8. In the Decorative Sections flowers need not be grown by the exhibitor but must be arranged by the exhibitor.
- 9. In the Jam & Needlework Sections all exhibits must have been made by the exhibitor.
- 10. Entries for Arts and Crafts (Classes 78 to 132) will ONLY be accepted between 10.00am and 8.00pm on Friday 22nd August.
- 11. Entries for all other sections Horticulture (Classes 1 to 55) and Home Industries (Classes 56-77) will be accepted between 10.00am and 8.00pm on Friday 22nd August and from 9.00am to 10.00am on the morning of the show, Saturday 23rd August. No entries will be accepted after this time.
- 12. The decision of the judge in all cases will be final.
- 13. All exhibits must not have been exhibited previously in Culmore Annual Show.
- 14. Exhibits must be produced / grown by the exhibitor or been the property of the exhibitor for at least two months prior to The Show.
- 15. Personal identification marks, signatures etc. must be covered prior to the exhibit being staged.
- 16. Labels will be issued for each exhibit on receipt of entry form and entry fee and must be attached to the exhibits before entering the Show rooms. This rule must be strictly observed.
- 17. Exhibitors are requested to provide their own vases, glass jars etc and to name all exhibits as far as possible.
- 18. All cups and trophies should be returned to Culmore Community Hub not later than 10th May 2025. Written certificate to this effect to be signed on receipt of trophy.
- 19. While CCP will exercise every care, all exhibits, personal property etc will be at the risk of the exhibitors. CCP will not be liable for compensation for loss or damage by theft or any cause whatsoever.
- 20. Exhibits may not be removed from The Show before 4.30pm.
- 21. Entries will not be accepted from professionals in their own subject.
